STANDING COMMITTEE REPORTS

Membership Letter Update: As of this writing (March 11), the letter has been submitted to the printer for distribution.

Community Response Committee:

- (i) LMHS Webcams: Karen Gotlieb gave a summary of the status of the situation. Various community groups are being formed. It was decided this is not a Civic Association issue and the PWCA will not take sides.
- (ii) Snow Removal: In addition to the aforementioned Commissioner’s Report, various problems were noted in several areas, i.e., due to cutbacks,

removal was less than satisfactory; some fire hydrants were covered by the plowing as well as curbside handicap areas; roads were not pre-treated.

- (iii) Lankenau Hospital: The hospital has purchased property on a cul-de-sac off of Lancaster Ave. (Wood Circle?). Before we take sides regarding the hospital's intentions for this property, more information should be obtained as to what Lankenau is actually planning for this area.
- (iv) Howard's Pharmacy: Tony Gill reported that the two men who broke in and burglarized Howard's in December are in custody, and one has been indicted in Federal District Court.

Programs Committee

- (i) The **PWCA SPRING SOCIAL** will be held Sunday, April 18, in the PWES Cafetorium from 4-7 p.m. A list was distributed for Volunteer Sign-Up, helping with Set-Up, providing refreshments, etc.
