

MAY 2010 PWCA MEETING

President's Report: Tony Gil reported that the LM Town Watch has requested a \$75 annual donation. A motion for an annual donation was made and approved.

Dana Axelrod spoke on behalf of the "Traffic Triangle" ongoing project. Jeannie Benedict volunteered to help. Also, Dana requested a \$65 donation for this year, and \$150 per year thereafter. It was decided to wait till after the July 4 carnival to approve any further annual donations, and receive input from Gary Friedlander before approving financial commitments.

Rick Churchill said the Commissioner's report could wait till our next meeting (June 3).

Membership Committee: We have collected \$3,200 in dues, and have 198 members.

Garden for the Blind Committee: Bob Levine reported that the Ardmore Rotary has raised \$100,000. The Lower Merion Conservancy will take over maintenance, but has requested neighborhood commitment/participation. i.e., weeding, etc.

PWCA Expansion Committee: Federation Meeting on Boundaries determined we cannot expand boundary; however, this issue will be addressed at a later PWCA meeting.

The balance of the meeting was devoted to the **JULY 4TH CARNIVAL Planning:**

Various volunteers said they would perform the same functions that they have in the past, i.e., prizes, various games, food service, etc. The facility (Kaiserman JCC) and parade route have been established. We are in the process of selecting a Grand Marshal for this year's parade.

There is still a need (and many openings!) for additional volunteers to help out with this annual (since 1947!) event.

The next Civic Association meeting will be held **Thursday, June 3, at 7:30 p.m.** in the Penn Wynne Library.
